

Springview Mini Goldendoodles Health Warranty and Purchase Contract

This contract is between Springview Mini Goldendoodles (Hereafter "Breeder") and _____ (Hereafter "Buyer"). This contract is entered into on _____ and pertains to the Mini Goldendoodle with microchip number _____ born on _____ sired by _____ of _____ .

Breeder's Responsibility:

The Breeder certifies that the above described Mini Goldendoodle is of sound health at time of sale, is up to date on any immunizations appropriate for the puppy's age and has been dewormed. The Buyers have 3 days from the date of delivery to have above puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian. If puppy is found to have a pre-existing condition which deems puppy to be in poor health, the Buyers have the option to return the puppy to the Breeder, at Buyer's own expense, for a full refund of purchase price or to request a replacement puppy if one is available. If no puppy is available, the Buyers may request a puppy from the next upcoming litter. If Buyer chooses to keep said puppy, Breeder will reimburse medication expenses for said pre-existing condition up to and not to exceed the purchase price paid for the puppy. All expenses must be reasonable and customary for the diagnosis made and the diagnosis may be subject to a second opinion at the Breeder's discretion and expense prior to any reimbursement. Buyer must submit bill from veterinarian for any reimbursement requested. If above referenced puppy is not examined by a licensed veterinarian within the three day period following the puppy leaving the possession of the Breeder, this warranty and all of it's contents will be null and void.

The Breeder provides a two year warranty against debilitating Hip Displasia, for two years from the date of sale. Should the dog be found to have HD in the first two years, Buyer must provide Breeder with proof in the form of documentation from either PennHip or OFA. Breeder reserves the right to confirm all results. If it is confirmed that dog indeed has debilitating HD, Breeder will provide either a replacement puppy or a refund up to the purchase amount of the puppy for treatment expenses. If Buyer requests a replacement puppy, Buyer assumes all costs for shipping of said replacement puppy. Affected above referenced dog does not need to be returned to us. This warranty on HD will be voided if dog is ever allowed to become overweight or if it is found that the dog's developing joints have been overstressed at any point during the warranty period.

The Breeder also provides a two year warranty against all serious genetic life altering disorders. In the event that the dog exhibits symptoms of a suspected genetic condition, the Buyer must supply Breeder with any and all requested veterinary records and test results to be evaluated at Breeder's expense for a second opinion from a veterinarian of their choice. Should above referenced puppy be diagnosed within a two year period from date of sale to indeed have a serious genetic life altering genetic disorder, Buyer may request a replacement puppy from the next available litter, or reimbursement up to the purchase price of the puppy for medical treatment this genetic disorder. The dog need not be returned to Breeder. Any shipping fees for replacement puppy will be the responsibility of the Buyer. The payment of fees to treat the illness will be paid to the veterinarian treating the dog for the disorder, upon submission of receipts documenting the treatment. If the dog is covered by a pet insurance policy, only those costs related to the genetic disorder, that are not paid for by the insurance policy will be reimbursed.

Buyer's Responsibility:

The Buyer agrees to pay the Breeder the sum of \$_____. A deposit of \$_____ and final payment of \$_____ has already been paid to Breeder.

The Buyer is responsible for any costs associated with transportation or shipping of the dog.

The Buyer agrees to take the above mentioned puppy to a licensed veterinarian within 3 days of leaving possession of Breeder. If there are any concerns, Buyer agrees to contact Breeder within 48 hours.

The Buyer agrees that the above mentioned puppy will be housed indoors.

The Buyer agrees to feed their dog only premium quality food for the health and well being of the dog.

The Buyer agrees to maintain their Springview Mini Goldendoodle at a healthy weight.

The Buyer agrees to make and keep annual veterinary appointments and to keep current with all recommended vaccinations and to administer heartworm medication year round.

The buyer agrees to attend at least ONE basic obedience class with their puppy within the first year.

The Buyer agrees to postpone strenuous, repetitive exercise until after their Springview Mini Goldendoodle is over one year of age.

The Buyer agrees to never place their Springview Mini Goldendoodle in a shelter, pound, or other similar facilities or research laboratory.

The Buyer agrees that if it is ever unable to keep or properly care for their Springview Mini Goldendoodle for any reason, they will immediately contact Breeder for re-homing options.
